There is a lot planned, so here's the schedule.

Saturday, April 28th

Meet at Nut-Zee's Inn on County Highway B in Harrison for lunch at noon. Annual organizational meeting will start promptly after lunch.

From Rhinelander, take State Highway 17 south to County Highway D. Turn right on County Highway D (West) to County Highway B. Turn left (East) on County Highway B to Nut-Zee's Inn, which is approximately one mile from intersection of B and D. (St. Augustine's church is located at the junction of D and B.)

Our ride begins after the meeting with a ride through the Harrison Hills passing many glacial lakes through thick forests of maples and birch. From the Harrison Hills, we travel southwest to Merrill on paved back roads where we pick-up State Highway 107 and follow the Wisconsin River to Tomahawk.

We check in at the Comfort Inn located at the junction of State Highway 86 and US Highway 51. After check-in, we continue our ride through the Tomahawk area in and around the Lake Nokomis, ending at Bootlegger's Supper Club, as guests of Bunnie and Bill Klula. We should be able to entice one of them into telling us the role this historic place had in the bootlegging era.

After dinner, we return to the Comfort Inn for the night.

Sunday, April 29th

Sleep in, or attend church services at one of Tomahawk's churches. Check out at 10:00 and we continue our ride cross country through Spirit to Rib Lake where we will enjoy brunch at Camp 28, owned by retired NASCAR driver Dave Marcus. We hope to be able to have brunch in the NASCAR Room, which is filled with NASCAR memorabilia and Dave's trophies.

After brunch, we travel to Timm's Hill, the highest point in Wisconsin. The adventurous may walk to the observation tower and climb to the top and view Wisconsin coming alive in the spring. Here our tour ends, but a great season begins.

Our block of rooms will be held until March 28th. After that date, the rate will be honored on a space available basis. The Comfort Inn has



a beautiful indoor pool and whirlpool as well as exercise room.
